1. Five Essays - which are themed pieces:

- I. Urban Landscape
- II. Georgia Photo-reportage
- III. WW 1 images taken on The Somme battlefield
- IV. The Coal Coast which is macro and textures photography in East Durham, which includes some locations used in the film GET CARTER
- V. Pure Landscape which is Winter and Autumn in Scotland.

2. India and Other Stories:

Travel and photo - journalism in India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Cuba, USA and Australia, also Georgia and Poland and various bits of Europe

3. The Great Divide:
